



## BARK CENTRAL DOG PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Watch your dog and keep him or within your command at all times, keeping your dog's leash with you.
- No dog treats or food of any kind is allowed in the off-leash areas of the park. This includes in your pockets or purse as well. Drinks are permitted.
- Dogs must be on leash entering and leaving the park. When in the off-leash areas, they must be off leash, except in the case when you must correct or remove the dog.
- Children under 14 years of age are NOT allowed in the off-leash areas of the park. Children under 18 must be supervised by a parent or guardian. Any damage to park facilities caused by children will be the liability of the parent or guardian.
- Dogs over 7 months of age must be spayed or neutered to enter the park. Some exceptions may be made by management.
- No bullies! Rough play is fine as long as it is consensual. Rough play and chasing are not acceptable if any of the dogs involved or owners are not comfortable with the situation.
- Dogs must be current on all vaccinations for entry.
- Owners MUST clean up after their dogs. Failure to do so may result in revocation of membership privileges.
- Do not let anyone other than you, your guests and paid for dog guests through the member gate at any time, regardless of what they tell you. Direct them to the office. Make sure you close the gate after yourself, even if people are waiting to enter.
- Non-member dogs – members may bring non-member guest dogs with them only during park office hours and after screening and upon paying the visitor fee. A visitor dog may not be brought into the park during any other times unless prior arrangements have been made with management.
- If you dog digs holes you MUST fill them in.
- Excessive barking will not be allowed and you may be asked to leave the park.
- If aggressive behavior is observed, take action immediately. Move your dog to another area of the park or leave the park. Please report incidents to management.
